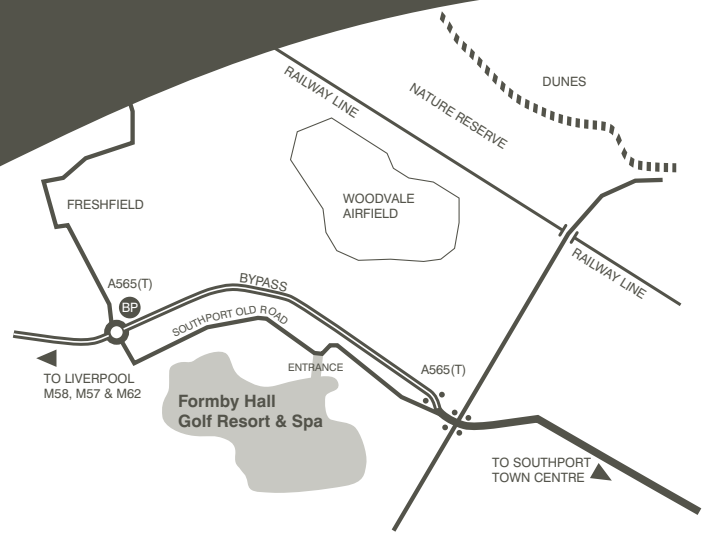

Formby Hall Golf Resort & Spa is situated in the North West of England ideally located for golfers visiting one of the three Royals; Royal Birkdale within 10 minutes drive, Royal Liverpool within 30 minutes drive and Royal Lytham & St Annes within an hours drive.

By Car from the North & South

Directions from the M6, follow signs for the M58 or M57. Time approx. 20 minutes from the M57 to Formby Hall Golf Resort & Spa. Follow signs Liverpool Southport to the end of the M58. Go through the traffic lights to the next set and then straight ahead up to the set of lights by the Police station. Turn right following signs for the A565 Formby. Stay on this road and at the second roundabout take third exit signposted Formby Hall Golf Resort & Spa. Follow Old Southport Road until the signs for Formby Hall Golf Resort & Spa.

Directions from the M62, follow signs to the M57. Time approx. 20 minutes from the M57 to Formby Hall Golf Resort & Spa.

Towards the end of the M57 signposted A5036. Keep in the 2nd lane and go through the middle set of traffic lights to the next set. Turn left to the next set and then straight ahead up to the set by the Police station. Turn right following signs for the A565 Formby and Southport. Stay on this road and at the second roundabout take third exit signposted Formby Hall Golf Resort & Spa. Follow Old Southport Road until the signs for Formby Hall Golf Resort & Spa.

By Ferry to Formby Hall Golf Resort & Spa

Fleetwood to Larnie ferry with Stena Line approx one hour to Formby Hall Golf Resort & Spa. This port is located on the southern edge of Morecambe Bay at the mouth of the River Wyre in the north west of England.

• Up to 2 ferry crossings daily, 8 hour sailing • Seasonal timetable may apply

Liverpool ferry port to Formby Hall Golf Resort & Spa within 40 minutes. Is one of the UK's major Ports & covers both banks of the River Mersey, both in Liverpool and in Birkenhead. Liverpool Birkenhead Ferry Port handles millions of tonnes of freight each year as well as a growing number of ferry passengers. Liverpool Birkenhead Ferries sail to and from the cities of Belfast and Dublin. Birkenhead bound passenger ferries are operated by Norfolkline Irish Sea.
